Application requirements:

1. <u>A current resume and simple pdf portfolio</u> (max 10MB) showing <u>recent artwork</u> should be submitted via the following email <u>no later than March 01, 2023</u>: application@baer.is.

If the applicant has <u>a well-structured and up-to-date website</u>, which includes a personal cv and/or resume and good samples of recent artwork, the website can replace the required resume+portfolio as application material.

2. <u>One letter of reference</u> from a person who knows the applicant through artistic projects, other residency participation or work environment.

The letter of reference should be submitted directly from the person providing reference via the following email before <u>March 01, 2023</u>: reference@baer.is.

Description:

In the Baer residency, artists are given the opportunity to work, explore the Icelandic nature, interact with other artists and enjoy peace and silence as much as desired, and most importantly: experience the uniqueness of our closest environment. The dramatic setting of the Baer farm plays an important role in the deep influence that the Baer residents are left with after their visit. Talented artists come together as a group for two weeks, from different parts of the world, sharing their background and experiences, but working independently on their own theme/focus. An informal studio exhibition at the end of the residency is optional for each group.

What's included:

- Full accommodation in a private studio space Each studio space includes a bedroom, a small bathroom with a shower, and a large studio working area (approx 40m2 / 400sq.ft). See floor plan below.
- Basic breakfast supplies.
- High speed internet connection.
- Access to two photo printers, A4 and A3, and supply of print cartridges.
- Bed linens and towels.
- Laundry machine/dryer to share.
- Three bikes to share.

Responsibility of each participant:

- All travel arrangements and cost, to and from Baer Art Center.
- Your own lunches, dinners and snack, and some breakfast supplies.
- All necessary art supplies (we have some stock of leftover supplies that can be used as well).
- Personal expenses.

Gear/equipment to bring along:

- Hiking boots, warm sweater, rain- and windproof jacket, warm hat and mittens are a necessity for a visit to our part of the world.
- Swimsuit, since there is a very special swimming pool in the vicinity.
- Any special health or food items that are not readily available.

Other important information:

- Participants in the residency session need to make their own arrangement for travel from Reykjavík to Baer Art Center. Information on possible means of travel to Baer can be found under faq on our website.
- Pick-up of participants from the bus stop in the town of Saudárkrókur is offered for those who travel by bus from Reykjavík.
- Last day of the residency session and the departure date from Baer Art Center is Sunday, July 2nd.
- Regular scheduled trips to Hofsós (our nearby village) and to Saudárkrókur (the nearby town) will be offered during the residency session.
- Shopping for dinner supplies should be planned in an advance, as needed.
- Communal dinners are encouraged for the participants during their residency.
- The residency fee must be fully paid at least four weeks before the start of the program. It is payable with a credit card (Visa or Mastercard only) or with a wire transfer. The selected participants in the residency session will receive an invoice from Baer Art Center with all necessary information for the payment procedure.
